Evergreen and China Shipping in joint service linking China with US west coast ports of Oakland and Los Angeles

SHIPPERS desperate for space on the transpacific trades are likely to welcome a new joint service from Evergreen and China Shipping, which will link China with the US west coast ports of Oakland and Los Angeles.

In an interesting move, the service appears to be scheduled to run at normal sailing speeds, as it deploys five vessels and will have a 17-day transit time from the base port of Ningbo to Los Angeles.

The first sailing of the China/South US west Coast 2 (CPS2) service will take place on the May 29, when the *Ever Develop* leaves Qingdao, due to arrive in Oakland on June 13.

Five 4,000 teu vessels will operate the string, three from by Evergreen and two from China Shipping.
